We trekked there in April. As the world's media have shown, the whole village was obliterated by the first avalanche. The villagers taught me so many lessons of honesty. They also influenced and inspired me to advocate for nutrition promotion based on indigenous foods, and to believe in the revival of health systems based on indigenous and traditional knowledge.
